



中文简介：黄怒波 中坤集团董事长

1956 年生于兰州。1973 年中学毕业后，在宁夏回族自治区农村插队。1980 年毕业于北京大学中文系。1981 年至 1990 年，在中宣部工作，任处长、部党委委员。1990 年至今，历任中国市长协会中国城市出版社常务副社长、中国市长协会副秘书长、中国市长协会会长助理。1995 年 4 月，创办北京中坤投资集团。1996 年至 1998 年，在中欧国际工商学院学习，获 EMBA 学位。中坤集团以商业地产为主构建第四代商业模式，代表案例为建筑面积 43 万平方米的大型商业中心——北京大钟寺中坤广场。同时，构建了国际复合型度假产业体系，代表案例为宏村，以保护中国古村落为己任，成功保护了黄山脚下的中国皖南古民居村——宏村。2000 年，宏村入选“世界文化遗产”名录。连年入选“福布斯中国富豪榜”、“福布斯中国富豪榜慈善榜”及“胡润百富榜”、“胡润慈善榜”，2009 年被《福布斯》杂志评选为亚太慈善英雄。2011 年被中欧国际工商学院评选为“中欧校友年度人物”。

身为企业家，在集团成立之日提出了“让我们为社会再多做一些”的企业宗旨，坚持承担企业社会公民责任，并以实际行动践行承诺，通过对教育、文化以及社会弱势群体的资助支持回报社会。2008 年 5 月 4 日，在北京大学 110 周年校庆之际，与雷洁琼、任继愈、吴阶平、胡亚美、王忠诚、于敏、周光召、钟南山、樊锦诗、邓朴方共同被授予“北京大学杰出校友”称号，2011 年 10 月被评为北京大学中文系 100 周年百位知名系友之一。

身为诗人，笔名骆英，著有多部诗集和小说。最向往的事是做一个流浪诗人，浪迹于山野。2005 年 12 月，向中国诗歌界捐资人民币 3000 万元，支持中国诗歌事业的发展。2011 年 4 月，成为第一个成功登顶世界七大洲最高峰，徒步至南北极的诗人企业家。并著有《7+2 登山日记》，2011 年 11 月该书入选 2011 年度“中国最美的书”。

Huang Nubo- Chairman of Zhongkun Group

Huang Nubo was born in Lanzhou city in 1956 and was sent to the countryside of Ningxia Hui Autonomous Region to receive re-education after graduation from middle school in 1973. He graduated from Chinese Department of Beijing University in 1980. During 1981 to 1990, he worked in The Central Propaganda Department as Department Chief and party members. From 1990 until now, he has been working as Permanent Vice President to Chinese City Publishing House of Chinese Mayors Association, Deputy Secretary-general in Chinese Mayors Association, and President Assistant of Chinese Mayors Association. In April 1995, he established Beijing Zhongkun Investment Group. During 1996 to 1998, he was studying in China Europe International Business Academy and graduated with degree of EMBA. Zhongkun Group aims to build up the fourth generation business model based on commercial real estate. Its representative case is Zhongkun Square of Beijing Great Bell Temple which is a large-scale commercial center with 430 thousand sqm construction area. In the meantime, it built up the international compound holiday industrial model with the representative case of Hong Village. With the responsibility of protecting ancient villages in China, Zhongkun successfully protected Hong village, the ancient village located at the foot of Huangshan Mountain, south of Anhui province. In 2002, Hong village was listed into World Cultural Heritage. Huang Nubo was elected into a series of rankings, including Forbes Chinese Rich List, Forbes Chinese Charity Rich List, Hurun One Hundred Rich List, Hurun Charity List, and Forbes Asia Charity Heroes in 2009. In 2011, he was elected to be Annual Alumnus in CEIBS by CEIBS.

As an entrepreneur, Huang Nubo set up the company purpose as Let's Do More for Our Community on the first day of foundation. He always persists in undertaking the citizenship responsibility and implementing his promises in his actions. He supports making returns to society through funding education, culture and vulnerable groups. On May 4th, 2008, he was awarded as the "Outstanding Alumnus of Beijing University jointly by Lei Jieqiong, Ren Jiyu, Wu Jieping, Hu Yamei, Wang

Zhongcheng, Yu Min, Zhou Guangzhao, Zhong Nanshan, Fan Jinshi and Deng Pufang. In October 2010, he was awarded as One Hundred Famous Alumnus upon the 100th anniversary of Chinese Department of Beijing University.

As a poet, he published a number of poetry anthologies and novels with pen name of Luo Ying. He looks forward to become a wandering poet and lead a wild life. In December 2005, he donated 30 million Yuan to the poetry community to promote the development of Chinese poetry. In April 2011, he is the first poet and entrepreneur who successfully reached the highest summit among seven continents, and successfully reached the North and South poles, plus that he composed a poem collection named 7+2 Diary, which was elected to *the most beautiful book in China* 2011.

Return to the Community:

Huang Nubo has finished accumulated donation reaches 374 million Yuan in fields of culture, education and public charity.

In December 2005, Huang Nubo donated 30 million Yuan to the poetry community to promote the development of Chinese poetry.

In March 2008, Huang Nubo set up Zhongkun International Youth Funds to promote cultural communication between Chinese and USA youths.

On April 15th, 2008, Huang Nubo donated the Great Bell Temple Zhongkun Square worths of 100 million Yuan to Beijing University, and set up Beijing University Zhongkun Education Funds.

On December 1st, 2008, Huang Nubo donated 1 million Yuan to Tibet University and set up Zhongkun Funds to Tibet University.

2009, Huang Nubo donated 5 million Yuan to rebuild Tashilhunpo Monastery to improve the medical treatment environment.

On October 22nd, 2009, Zhongkun donated 2 million Yuan to build the Center Kindergarten of Tonggui town, Yinchuan City of Ningxia province, and this kindergarten has been transferred officially to Tonggui government.
